The price of Business Spot electric energy (c/kWh) for each delivery hour is in accordance with the spot electricity price that the Nord Pool Power Exchange has quoted for the Finnish price area.

Business Aika

The A pricing for Business Aika electricity shall be effective in the areas of those distribution networks, in which the conventional 2-rate metering divides the daytime consumption and night-time consumption of electricity so that the weekly number of night-time hours is 85-120. If the consumption of electricity is metered and registered by the hour, the daytime electricity unit charge shall be effective on weekdays, from Monday to Friday, 7 a.m.-8 p.m. except for public holidays. The night-time electricity unit charge shall be effective at other times, as well as on the eve of May 1st, Midsummer's Eve, Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve.

The D pricing shall be effective in the areas of those distribution networks, in which the conventional 2-rate metering divides the daytime consumption and night-time consumption of electricity so that the weekly number of night-time hours is 40-84.

If the consumption of electricity is metered and registered by the hour in a place of electricity use located in the D area, the daytime electricity unit charge shall be effective between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m. The night-time electricity unit charge shall be effective between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m.

The A pricing for Business Aika electricity shall be effective in the areas of the distribution networks of Helen Sähköverkko Oy and Vantaan Sähköverkot Oy. The D pricing shall be applied in all other network areas.

Business Kausi

Business Kausi electricity is sold in those distribution network areas in which the conventional 2-rate metering divides the consumption of electricity between winter day hours and other times so that the number of hours considered winter-day hours is at least 10 on every weekday in the winter months. The winter months form an uninterrupted period of at least four months, starting no later than 1 December and ending no sooner than 28 February.

If the consumption of electricity is metered and registered by the hour, the winter-day electricity unit charge shall be effective between 1 November and 31 March, every day from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m. The electricity unit charge for other times shall be effective at other times.

Business Kesä

The summertime electricity unit charge shall be effective between 1 April and 31 October. The wintertime electricity unit charge shall be effective at other times. Division of electricity consumption between the summer and winter seasons is evaluated on the basis of the electricity consumption data provided by the distribution system operator. Business Kesä electricity is sold to new contract-based sites, where the annual consumption of electricity is less than 100,000 kWh.

Business Käyttö

Business Käyttö electricity is sold to new contract-based sites where the annual consumption of electricity is less than 100,000 kWh.

Business Spot

A service charge is collected for all electricity supplied to the customer. If the consumption of electricity is not metered and registered by the hour, the monthly price of electricity is calculated using the type-load curve for group 3 specified in decision No. 491 of the Ministry of Trade and Industry. In two-rate metering (day/night), daytime electricity consumption is allocated to the period 7 a.m.-10 p.m., Mon.-Sun., if the duration of night-time is 40-85 h/week. If the duration of night-time is 85-120 h/week, daytime electricity consumption is allocated to the period 7 a.m.-8 p.m. on weekdays (Mon.-Fri.), excluding the eve of May 1st, Midsummer's Eve, Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve, as well as other public holidays. In two-rate metering (winter-day/other times), daytime electricity consumption on winter days is allocated to the period 7 a.m.-10 p.m. during the winter months (November-March).

Business Teho

The daytime electricity unit charge shall be effective between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m. The night-time electricity unit charge shall be effective at other times of day and night. The winter months are November, December, January, February and March. All other months are considered summer months. The active power value to be invoiced shall be the highest average hourly power of the month, metered during the validity of the daytime electricity unit charge. The use of Business Teho electricity requires a metering device which meters and registers the consumption of electricity by the hour.

Distribution and metering of electricity

The customer shall conclude a power network contract for each site to which electricity will be supplied with the distribution system operator. Each site shall have metering equipment suitable for the electricity product in question. If the size of the main fuse exceeds 63 A, the consumption of electricity shall be metered and registered by the hour.

Other terms and conditions

The prices shall be valid until further notice. The supply of electricity can be started no sooner than 15 days after receipt of the order. The entry into force of the contract will ultimately depend on the system operator's notification.

Electricity is sold at list prices to sites of corporate and public utility customers, where the annual consumption of electricity is less than 100,000 kWh.

The supply of electricity will not be based on the obligation to deliver laid down in section 21 of the Electricity Market Act. Unless some other agreement has been made, Helsingin Energia's Terms of Electricity Sales shall be applied. Any disputes derived from the electricity sale contract shall be settled by the Helsinki Court of First Instance.
